Dolphin Mania winners

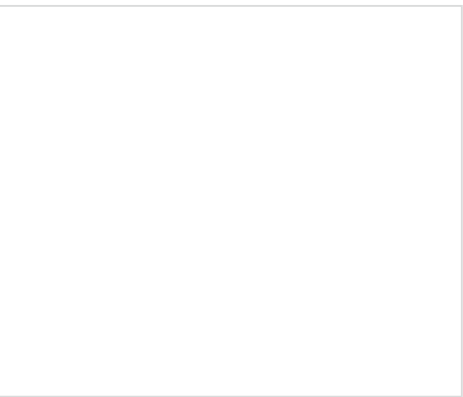

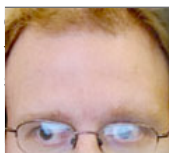
